

## **Directions to the Natural Animal Centre**

### By Air

- Cardiff International airport is just over one hour's drive from Carmarthen town centre.
- Heathrow International airport is approximately 4 hours drive away from Carmarthen. The road connection is a relatively simple trip down the main motorway – M4.

### By Rail

- One main line provides regular, fast services to Wales from London Paddington to Cardiff. Visitors can then change at Cardiff or Swansea for direct links to Carmarthen train station.

### By Road

- Carmarthen is easily reached by following the A48 from the end of the M4 if travelling from the East from Cardiff or London.
- If travelling from the North, the M5 runs from the North of England / Scotland and connects via the M50 / M42 to reach the M4.

### By Coach

- The National Express bus service links Carmarthen to all major towns in the UK and arrives in Carmarthen town centre.

### **Directions to NAC 1**

#### ***Natural Animal Centre, Penhill, Trawsmawr, Carmarthen, SA33 6ND***

- At the end of the M4 (travelling east to west), you will come to a roundabout; cross straight over following the road signed A48 to Carmarthen
- At the next roundabout, again cross straight over still following the A48
- At the third roundabout, take the second exit signed A40 to Fishguard and St Clears
- At the next roundabout, turn right signed to the Town Centre
- At the next roundabout, with Tesco and MFI on your left, turn left following the A4242 signed P (Parking) and Welsh Assembly Offices. Pass straight through the traffic lights at the entrance to Tesco.
- At the next roundabout, turn sharp right into St Catherine Street following the sign to the Golf Course
- At the first set of traffic lights, turn left into Water Street signed to the Golf Course and Trevaughan
- Pass through Trevaughan and keep on this road until you come to the Plough and Harrow pub on your right. From here the turning to the track to the farm is 1.1 miles ahead. Do not turn off - keep on the same road passing a church until you reach the track 1.1 miles ahead on your left hand side (there are a number of names of farms listed in white on the corner) and there is also a sign to the Tafarn y Cwm (the local pub). Turn left here and follow the road around to the right and to the left. Penhill is at the top of the hill on the right hand side.

### **Directions to NAC 2**

#### ***Natural Animal Centre, Troed Yr Rhiw, Cwmdud, Carmarthen, SA33 6XN***

- At the end of the M4 (travelling east to west), you will come to a roundabout; cross straight over following the road signed A48 to Carmarthen
- At the next roundabout, again cross straight over, still following the A48
- As you arrive in Carmarthen you reach a third roundabout. Take the second exit (straight ahead) signed A40 to Fishguard and St Clears
- At the next roundabout you will see a large Tesco's hypermarket in front of you, get in the right hand lane and turn right signed to the Town Centre
- At the next roundabout, with MFI on your left, move into the left hand lane to turn left following the A4242 signed P (Parking) and Welsh Assembly Offices
- You will pass through a set of traffic lights with Tesco's entrance on your left
- At the next roundabout, turn the sharp right into St Catherine Street following the sign to the Golf Course
- At the first set of traffic lights, turn left into Water Street signed to the Golf Course and Trevaughan
- Keep on this road passing through Trevaughan and then later passing the Plough and Harrow pub on your right. Stay on this road, do not turn off – you will pass a small church on a sharp left hand bend. Continuing on this road you will pass through a small hamlet – Bwlchnewydd, and pass signs to the village of Talog on your left. Keep following the road, for approx 3 miles, until you come down a slight hill approaching the village of Cynwyl Elfed.
- You will reach a T – junction. Turn left here. This is the main A484 that passes through Cynwyl Elfed travelling north up to Newcastle Emlyn.
- Drive through Cynwyl Elfed, passing the Curry Leaf on your right. You will go round a right hand bend – stay on this road – do not turn up the road ahead of you signed to Hermon. Follow the A484 for approx 3 miles until you reach the village of Cwmdud.
- You will see a pub ahead on the right – the Afon Duad pub. Opposite the pub is a sign to the Community Centre – turn left up this track. This track is the drive to NAC 2. Follow the track a few hundred yards and you will see a sign on the right directing you up a sloping track to the car park area.

### **Directions to NAC 1 from NAC 2**

- Exit NAC 2 by turning right out of the drive on to the A484 back towards Carmarthen.
- On entering Cynwyl Elfed continue around the sharp left hand bend, passing the turning up to Newcastle Emlyn on your right.
- Drive past the Curry Leaf and the Spar on your left.
- Take the turning on the right just after the public toilets, signed to Talog.
- Follow this road for approx 2 -3 miles, passing through Bwlchnewydd.
  
- Approx 0.5 mile past this hamlet is a turning on the right hand side – there is a sign on your left for Tafarn Y cwm. Turn right onto the 1 track road
- If you see a short row of ex council houses and 2 new houses being built on your left, you have gone past the turning!! (If you pass the Plough and Harrow pub on your left you have gone far too far!!)
- Having turned right towards Tafarn Y Cwm, follow this lane round two bends and up a slight incline. As you near the top of the hill the Natural Animal Centre – Penhill is found on the right hand side – we have a wooden gate with white concrete pillars.
